1. Fear is a Foundational Intellectual Motivator
What do I fear?

- Wisdom’s open invitation to know and grow
- Our initiative is needed to learn and change in behavior

2. Fear of the LORD is a Relationship that Gives Wisdom

- Direction for what is right and good
- Discretion to navigate ways of the world
- Deliverance from every form of evil
