**A Read Luke 16: 1-9**

- 3 Explain the surprise ending. What bothers you about this parable?
- 4 What did this bad manager do right that we should learn from? (verse 9)

**B Read Luke 16: 10-15 Underline the word "faithful".**

- 1 What is the "little" referring to in Jesus' teaching?
- 2 What is the "much" referring to?
- 3 Give examples of being faithful with "little"
- 4 Give examples of being faithful over what is another's.

- 5 Why is it impossible to serve God and money?
- 6 Why is the topic of money such a sensitive spiritual nerve?

Who has been an example to you of someone who has used money well to serve God? How have you imitated them?

Is there a "push back" reaction in your spirit today? How?

Are there changes God wants to make in your actions concerning your use of what He has given you?
