Planting Kindness in our Families
Galatians 6: 1-10

ICE BREAKER: Do you have a green thumb? What kind of seeds have you planted that have grown? Or What is something you have restored ?

SHARE: Any answered prayers from last week in the group.

Pray thanking God for His kindness.

A. Read Galatians 6: 1- 3

1. How should we respond to another believer when they sin?
2. When someone sins, what needs to be restored?
3. Why the caution of temptation?
4. How is bearing each “other’s burdens” acting like Jesus? How is it fulfilling the law of Christ (Gal.5: 14)?
5. What is the danger of comparing ourselves to others who appear to be less spiritual?

B. Read Galatians 6: 4-5

1. Pulling our own weight is part of working together. In what ways do you share “jobs” in your family? What are your chores at home?
2. How does 6:14 relate to doing our tasks cheerfully and faithfully?

C Read Colossians 6: 6-10

1. What does verses 6-8 say to about paying church leadership. What other good things could be shared? How is this “sowing” eternal seed?
2. What is the challenge Paul is giving to our view of finances? (6:7,8)
3. What is the promise and encouragement in verse 9? How does this apply to being a parent, a spouse, a servant of Jesus?

APPLICATION

1. Is there a relationship or ministry where you are tempted to “give up” planting seeds of kindness? What would be a more “eternal” perspective?
2. Read 6: 10 How can you start making a lifestyle of “doing good”? Be specific, thinking of one person, and one action.
