1. **The Results of our Sin.**

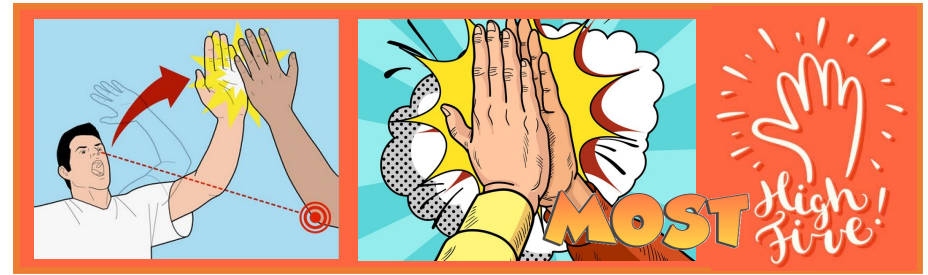
- Alienated from God Colossians 1:21
- Indebted and Under Punishment Colossians 2:14
- Condemned—Destined for Death Colossians 2:14

2. **The Response of the Cross.**

- He has Reconciled you. Colossians 1:22
- He has Presented you as Holy. Colossians 1:22
- He has Canceled all your Debt. Colossians 2:14

3. **The Reality we live in.**

- No more Sin! Colossians 2:14
- No more Condemnation! Colossians 2:14
- No more Shame! Colossians 2:15
