## OVERVIEW

---

After Jesus is crucified and buried, Jesus rises from the dead on the third day. Jesus gives us victory over Satan, sin, and death through his resurrection!

## QUESTIONS: 1 CORINTHIANS 15:50-58

---

1. Jesus gives me victory over S\_\_\_\_, s\_\_\_\_, and d\_\_\_\_\_.
2. What kind of transformation will occur at the resurrection?
3. What is the significance of the statement, "we will all be changed—in a flash, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet"?
4. How are our perishable bodies contrasted with the imperishable bodies we will receive?
5. What does the victory over death through Jesus Christ mean to you personally?
6. How does Paul's declaration that "death has been swallowed up in victory" offer hope to believers?
7. How does understanding the victory given through Jesus Christ inspire you to live a steadfast and immovable life in your faith?

## APPLICATION

---

1. How does the promise of receiving an imperishable body at the resurrection affect your perspective on current physical challenges or suffering? How can you share the hope of the resurrection and victory over death with others in your life who may be struggling with fear or uncertainty?
2. Have you memorized the five finger points? Share them with a partner.
  - A. Jesus – Jesus came from heaven to teach us the Kingdom of God.
  - B. The Cross – Christ Removes Our Sin and Shame.
  - C. He Rose Again – Jesus gives us victory over Satan, sin, and death.
  - D. He Ascended to Heaven – Where He now rules and prays for us. JESUS is LORD!
  - E. He's Coming Back – To judge the world and bring eternal justice.
