

The Gospel: The Resurrection | Acts 2:32-36

Ohana Group Discussion Questions: Week of August 18th, 2024

OVERVIEW

Peter proclaims that God raised Jesus from the dead and exalted him to His right hand of the Father, fulfilling the Old Testament prophecies. He declares that Jesus, whom the people crucified, is both Lord and Messiah. This message emphasizes the resurrection, ascension, and the necessity of recognizing Jesus as the promised Savior!

OHANA TIME!

Icebreaker: If you had to describe yourself using only three words, which ones would you choose? **Or** If you could have dinner with any historical figure, who would it be and what would you ask them?

Activity: Invite somebody new to your group!

PRAYER

Pray as a group: Pray using the ACTS prayer model. (Adoration, Confession, Thanksgiving, and Supplication)

QUESTIONS: ACTS 2:32-36

1. In what ways should Jesus' exaltation to God's right-hand shape our worship and devotion to him?
2. What does it mean that Jesus has been exalted to the right hand of God, and how should this influence our view of his role and authority?
3. What does this passage reveal about the relationship between Jesus' resurrection, ascension, and his role as Lord and Messiah?
4. How can the truth of Jesus' exaltation and lordship provide comfort and hope in difficult circumstances?
5. What role does the Holy Spirit play in empowering us to testify to the truth of Jesus' resurrection and lordship, as seen in Peter's sermon?

APPLICATION

1. In Jesus' ascension, he has given us the Holy Spirit who guides and empowers us to accomplish his mission. What mission has Jesus placed upon you, his disciples, until his glorious return? Think in two categories...individual and communal (Ohana Group, church).
2. Have you memorized the five finger points? Share them with a partner.
 - A. Jesus – Jesus came from heaven to teach us the Kingdom of God.
 - B. The Cross – Christ Removes Our Sin and Shame.
 - C. He Rose Again – Jesus gives us victory over Satan, sin, and death.
 - D. He Ascended to Heaven – Where He now rules and prays for us. JESUS is LORD!
 - E. He's Coming Back – To judge the world and bring eternal justice.
