3. How can we ensure that our actions, even in ordinary activities like eating or drinking, reflect a heart that desires to glorify God?
4. How can our church collectively focus on glorifying God in everything we do as a community?
5. What does it mean to "imitate Paul as he imitates Christ," and how does that challenge your own walk of faith?
6. What specific qualities of Christ do you think Paul was encouraging the Corinthians to imitate, and how can we apply those qualities today?
7. Who are the Christ-like examples in your life, and how have they influenced your faith?
8. In what ways can our church community collectively imitate Christ and set an example for others to follow?

1. What are some practical ways we can glorify God in our work, relationships, and leisure activities?
2. Who in your life can you intentionally mentor or encourage by modeling Christ-like behavior?
