1 The Covering of Authority from Christ 11: 1-16

God's love provides layers of protection 1 Cor 13:7

In prayer we honor Christ as our Head 11:4,5,13

We respect order, authority, accountability through our voluntary submission—this leads to victory!

Dads teach children to honor their mom. 11-16

Moms teach children to honor their dads.

2. Setting A Table of Thanksgiving 11: 17-34

Recognize Christ as the Head of the Table. 17-22

No: divisions rivalry gluttony drunkenness humiliation

Remember the cross as the source of all thanks. 23-26

Examine your heart and lead in showing grace. 27-32

Wait: for everyone/ pray/ all served/ the cook to start 33

Wait: people to speak/ needs of others/ give blessing

Wait: to be excused/ help clean up/ say thank you!
