**The Good News:** Lk 4:18 & Is 61:1-2

We are designed by God to live in both the physical and spiritual realm, in relationship with and dependence upon our Heavenly Father. Col 2:16; Pr 3:5-6; Jn 5:19-20; Gn 1-3

The World, the Flesh, & the Devil are against this happening: Ep 6:10–12

**Seven Critical Issues or Areas** that affect negatively our relationship with Jesus and with others. We will not experience freedom, if we have:

- 1. Dabbled in the occult Dt 18:9-14; I Cor 10:14-22; 2 Cor 4:1-2
- 2. Believed lies Jn 8:31-32; 2 Cor 11:3; 2 Tm 2:24-26; Rv 12:9
- 3. Held onto bitterness & resentment Ep 4:26-27; 2 Cor 2:10-11
- 4. Rebelled against God-established authority Rm 13:1-7; I Sm 15: 23
- 5. Walked in pride or fear Js 4:6-7; I Pt 5:6-10; I Tm 1:7
- 6. Engaged in sins of the flesh & developed unhealthy soul ties Pr 29:6; Mk 7:20-23; Ga 5:19-21; I Cor: 6:16-19; Mt 19:5; Mt 5:28; Ep 5:28-31
- 7. Continued in the iniquity of our ancestors Ex 20:4-6; Lv 26:39-42; Jn 9:1

Good News- Tools to help: Js 4:6-7

**Two Key Truths** based on a **Biblical Worldview** that we need to understand:

- **1. Authority in Christ:** Right & Ability to Rule Mt 28:19-20 Ep 2:1-6; Mk1:27; Mt 8:8-12; Mt 16:19; Mt 18:19; Lk 9:1; Lk 10:19
- 2. Legal Ground or Permission Given to Our Enemy:
  - \* **God's Sovereignty -** Job 1,2; 2 Cor 12:9; Lk 22:31,32; Lk 8:32; I Cor 10:13
  - \* Free Will of Man Ep 4:26; Js 4:6-8: I Pet 5:6-8: 2 Cor 11:3: 2 Cor 2:11: Ep 6:10-12
    - A. Ancestors
    - **B. Us -** S.O.U.L. -- R.I.P.S.

The Steps to Freedom in Christ & Breaking Free 101: These are tools that can help you connect with the Lord for the purpose of finding freedom from spiritual and emotional baggage and bondage. Hb 12:1-2

**Simple process:** After a half hour of teaching related to each Step, you will:

- \* **Ask** the Lord to bring to your mind the ways permission may have been given to the enemy in each *Step* Mt 7:7
- \* Listen and be aware of what the Holy Spirit brings to your mind and remembrance Jn 14:26
- \* **Respond** with: *Confession* I Jn 1:9; *Renunciation* 2 Cor 4:2; Lk 14:33; Ezk 14:6; Dan 4:27; *Repentance* 2 Tim 2:24-26

## The 4-C's Model for Praying and Dealing with our Enemy:

- 5. *Confessing* agreeing with God about sin, admitting that it was wrong 1 Jn 1:9; Lv 26:41
- **6.** *Cancelling* legal ground & jurisdiction given to enemy, renouncing permission given Ep 4:26-27; 2 Cor. 4:2 Lk 14:33 Ezk 14:6; Dn 4:27
- **7.** *Commanding* the enemy to leave, evict him, stop any influence, using your authority to bind & evict Lk 9:1; Lk 10:19
- **8.** *Committing* ground in our lives to Christ, His Lordship and the Holy Spirit's influence Lk 11:24-26

Confidentially, you will be processing 7 issues with a partner - preferably with your spouse or someone of the same gender. Rm 10:9-10; Js 5:16; Mt 18:19-20; Ecc 4:9-10.

This is for Every Believer. We all have ancestral iniquity which we need to deal with; believed lies fed to us by the world, the flesh, and the devil; carried resentment & unforgiveness; rebelled against God-established authority; walked in pride and fear; committed fleshly sin; and developed unhealthy soul-ties (that need to be broken).
