OVERVIEW

Sometimes the storm is too big; but God will come looking for you.

OHANA TIME!

Activity: Organize a game to get to know each other better! (ex. Two truths and lie, Charades)

PRAYER

Pray in groups of 2-3: Ask God for his wisdom and comfort for any challenges/trials you may be facing.

Pray as a group: "Consider it pure joy, whenever you face trails of many kinds, because you know the testing of your faith produces perseverance." (James 1:2-3) Ask God for joy and give Him thanksgiving!

BIBLE: READ GENESIS 1

- 1. What's the worst storm you've been through? Take a moment and write down something about that storm.
- 2. Today's main passage is Genesis 1. As we read and work our way through it, write down some reflections that you feel might help you when storms come.
- 3. Discuss this statement...
 - a. God doesn't want your circumstances to dictate your <u>life</u>, to trump His <u>word</u>, or to trump His <u>presence</u>.
- 4. Taking a look at your reflection in Question #1, what do you think you will do to prepare for another similar storm?

APPLICATION

What kind of season do you think you are in now? Do you think your season is temporary or permanent. If God can change the seasons, can he change your season to? How can God overcome any storm you are facing?
