I. We Serve a God of Authority

- 1. He spoke the world into existence. Genesis 1:3
- 2. We can only give authority to one. Matthew 6:24
- 3. It's a la carte—or Chef's choice
 - A. A la carte
 - •Friends and family Mark 3:20-21
 - •Media and culture Romans 12:1-2
 - •Substances 1 Corinthians 6:12
 - •My emotions and/or experiences Jeremiah 17:9
 - •And the problem with me being my ultimate authority? Judges 17:5-6
 - B. Chef's choice
 - •God is our ultimate authority. Matthew 28:18
 - •His authority is expressed in Scripture. 2 Timothy 3:16

II. Scripture and Marriage Matthew 19:3-4

- 1. Marriage is the union of one man and one woman. Matthew19:4-5
- 2. God has called husbands and wives to put their mates' interests and desires ahead of their own. Philippians 2:3-4
- 3. God has called husbands and wives to be truthful and to have wholesome, upbuilding, grace-filled communication. Ephesians 4:25,29
