Disciple Makers: Sending Out | Mark 6:6-12

Ohana Group Discussion Questions: Week of May 5th, 2024

OVERVIEW

Jesus sends out the twelve, giving them authority to preach and cast out impure spirits.

OHANA TIME!

Icebreaker: Tell the story of a memorable group project! (Successful, funny, or otherwise.) Or What is a time you wanted to do something a certain way but discovered following the directions was really the best option?

Activity: Play a game of telephone! Have the first person make a request (e.g. "Please get me a fruit.") and pass that request along whispering to each other. Then, see what the last person does for the first person!

PRAYER

Pray in two's or three's, pray for each other's "Nazareth" i.e. family, friends, workplace that needs Jesus.

Pray for an area of ministry that the authority and healing power of Christ would come in power.

QUESTIONS: MARK 6:6-12

- 1. Jesus brings the disciples and sends them out with authority! Name some of the things the disciples have seen Jesus do (from Mark 3 till now).
- What are some of your thoughts and feelings hearing that Jesus has given you authority to do some of those same things?
- 3. Jesus sends the disciples out in pairs. What are some of the benefits of going with a partner? What are some of the challenges? Get practical! (This will be a little easier if you've traveled somewhere with a friend or family)
- 4. What are some of the things Jesus commanded them to DO?
- 5. What are some of the things Jesus commanded them to NOT DO?
- 6. What do you think Jesus meant when He said shaking the dust off from a place which rejected them stood "as a testimony against them?" What can we learn from this?

APPLICATION

- 1. Is there something you've been doing in your Christian life that you can bring someone else to journey with you?
- 2. Think of a rejection or difficulty in your life right now. Now think about it considering Jesus ruling and reigning. Is there a different set of actions you can take in that rejection or difficulty?
- 3. Is there "another town" you believe God is calling you to bring His light to? Who has God brought to you to journey to that "town?"
