1. Recognize Our Human Ambition for Greatness 35-37

* True glory and greatness are not something we are given
but something we become.

* Through following Jesus—greatness is for every one!

2. The Path to Greatness 38-40

Glory = the total obedience to the Father’s will.

Cup = suffering for the LORD’s call that is bigger than me.

Baptism = immersed in death of self, for the life of God.

3. Greatness Redefined 41– 45

◆ The opposite of great > to lord over someone.

◆ To become great > be a servant.

◆ To be first > be a slave.
