Psalm 22

The p<u>ain</u> of a<u>ffliction</u> and s<u>eparation</u> is followed by . . . The p<u>romise</u> of a<u>ffirmation</u> and s<u>alvation</u>.

"He has not despised or disdained the suffering of the afflicted one; he has not hidden his face from him but has listened to his cry for help" 24

2 We will Never be Forsaken by God! Mk 15:33-38 God's holiness meets with the horror of our sin on the cross.

The Father turned His face away from His Son.

Jesus knows the greatest pain of broken relationships.

3 We Have Eternal Fellowship with God Heb 10:19-25 Confidence to enter by the blood of Jesus our Great High Priest
