Ohana Group Discussion Questions: Week of April 27, 2025

OVERVIEW

The resurrection of Jesus Christ gives to all who believe in Him, victory over Satan, sin and death forevermore.

OHANA TIME!

Icebreaker: What is the worst lie you did as a child? -or- What is an absolute, unwavering "Gospel Truth" thing you live by today?

Activity: Start brainstorming and planning how your Ohana group will help with the Mission Fair coming up on May 25th. Each Ohana group should be supporting/praying for a KUC missionary. If you don't know who it is, please contact Pastor John Barrow.

PRAYER

Let your prayers focus on:

- 1.) Jesus dying on the cross for our sins.
- 2.) Jesus being buried in the tomb for three days.
- 3.) Jesus being raised to life / The Resurrection. He is Risen!
- 4.) How Jesus appears to His disciples in person, but to us now, we can believe in all He is and what He currently does in our lives according to the Scriptures.

BIBLE: READ 1 CORINTHIANS 15:1-5

QUESTIONS TO DISCUSS

1. Why do we need to be reminded of the Gospel in our daily lives? (v. 1)
2. What does it look like for a person to "take a stand" on the Gospel? (v. 1) Do you see this applicable today?
3. According to this passage what is of "first importance"? (v. 3)
4. What does "According to the Scriptures" mean? Why is this phrase repeated twice in this passage? (v. 3-4)

APPLICATION

1. What does "standing in awe before God" mean to you? After defining this phrase, please answer next, **question #4** of the application questions. Then chose at least one more application question from either questions #2, #3, #5 – or you can answer all of them if you have the time.
2. What personal thoughts about Jesus dying on the cross for our sins make you stand in awe before God? (v. 3)
3. What personal thoughts about Jesus being buried make you stand in awe before God? (v. 4)
4. **What personal thoughts about the resurrection / Jesus being raised on the third day, makes you stand in awe before God? (v. 4)**
5. What personal thoughts about Christ appearing to His followers after His death, makes you stand in awe before God? (v. 5)
