18.19

God's Holy Love is in great contrast with worldly wickedness.

God's character protects the righteous while judging the wicked.

God's judgements are: universal, according to truth, impartial, according to motive and conduct. Romans 2: 1-16

The cries for judgment conflict with protection of the righteous.

Bold, humble, persistent prayer teaches us God's heart.
