Psalm 51

1 Cleaning the Heart

2 Samuel 11, 12

Contrition is the moving force of the process of repentance.

Heartfelt sorrow for sin that offends God.

Hatred of our sin and renouncing of sin.

Resolution to change: be forgiven be reconciled

2 Creation of a New Heart

Have mercy on me, O God. I openly confess I am a helpless sinner.

Cleanse me from evil. I have violated You God, my heart is broken.

I am guilty. Your judgment upon me is deserved.

I claim the cross of Christ as my own.
I claim the righteousness of Christ as my own.
