1 Keep Watch! Submit to our Master’s Request 26:38

Strategic prayer circles: whole group, inner three, alone with Jesus

⇒ Watch Jesus! - strengthen him in his time of need.

⇒ Watch for the enemy— sound the alarm of their arrival.

2 Watch and Pray Submit to our Master’s Warning 26:41

The work in front of us in vital!

Pray against the perils of temptation.

Pray against the weakness of our flesh and selfishness of our body.

3 Missing the Moment Submit to our Master’s Will 26:44

Submit to correction. Listen and learn in failure.

The disciples were unprepared to face the betrayer.

Submit to the Father. He has a higher plan and will than ours.
