In **Matthew 8:5-13**, a Centurion approaches Jesus on behalf of His suffering servant. After hearing his plea for help and healing, Jesus agrees to his request and to travel to his home. Amazed by his response, Jesus declared to everyone within ear-shot that this was great faith. Then He turned and told him that his servant was set free from his affliction.
