OVERVIEW

Jesus must become greater and greater and I must become less and less. What an amazing statement that continues to echo and is relevant for us even today.

BIBLE: READ JOHN 3:22-36

QUESTIONS TO DISCUSS

1. Have you ever felt jealous or have complained but then realized it really wasn't about you, rather more about Jesus getting glory? If so, share your testimony.
2. What did Jesus do with His disciples, right after His previous encounter with Nicodemus the night before? (v. 22)
3. Is there a difference between John's baptisms and Jesus's baptisms? If so, what? (v. 22-23)
4. What was John's reasoning for Jesus to baptize more than him? (v. 27-29)
5. What does “above all” mean in John 3:31? What does this validate?
6. What happens to those who believe Jesus and what happens to those who reject Jesus? (v. 36)

APPLICATION

1. Have you been baptized? If so, what did that mean for you? If not, what is holding you back from getting baptized?
2. How can John 3:30 be significant for you in all areas of your life? Give an example.
3. Do you believe in Jesus, and have put your complete trust in Him? How does your decision impact what happens in 2026?
