Exodus 3:11: But Moses said to God, “Who am I that I should go to Pharaoh and bring the Israelites out of Egypt?”

Have you ever felt that God was asking you to do something, and your response was the same as Moses? This passage is full of excuses from Moses outlining why he is unqualified for the job. We, also often feel unqualified at the task set before us – Whether it be starting a new job or finding a new pastor. This passage shows us that if we do not feel qualified or good enough, it is exactly where God wants us to be. God’s power is perfected in our weakness (2 Corinthians 12:9). Our shortcomings put us in a position to rely on God. Why would we need to rely on God if we can do it in our own strength? Jesus would put it this way, “. . . apart from Me, you can do nothing.” John 15:5.

If you are in a place of feeling that God has given you a task that is too big, too hard, too difficult, or too overwhelming. Go to Him in prayer and ask HIM to be your strength. “My flesh and my heart may fail, but God is the strength of my heart and my portion forever.” (Psalm 73:26)
